Enjoy making meaningful math connections with your family this summer!

Play Monopoly — and be the banker.	Sort a package of colored candies and create a graph with them.	Count all the animals you see on a trip.	Play Rummikub®, Yahtzee®, or checkers together.	Use play money to purchase items from your pantry and around your home.
Create a summer-fun budget and decide as a family how to spend the money.	Calculate the cost of groceries while shopping.	Make a treat or dessert and measure the ingredients together.	Guess who will have the biggest stack of laundry and test your hypothesis by folding and stacking!	Use 1 quarter, 3 dimes, 4 nickels, and 10 pennies. Roll a die and grab that number of pennies. Exchange them for larger coins along the way. First player to a quarter wins!
Measure things with household objects — shoes, boxes, etc. How many boxes tall are you?	Tell time with a.m. or p.m.; midnight or noon; and digital or analog! Print this game for extra practice.	Clean out a space in your home and sort each item into one of three categories: keep, discard, or donate.	Make an inventory list of everything in your room or closet!	Trace circles from cups. Write math equations in the circles and answers on the cups. Match circles to cups.
Grab a deck of cards and play solitaire, put them in numerical order, build a house of cards, or play memory match!	Play Multominoes with this game board!	Play with a jump rope or Hula-Hoop® and count how many times you jump or how many times the hoop rotates.	Blow bubbles and count how many you can make from one breath.	Create a pile of dominoes and have each player pull one and add the two sides. The player with the highest number gets a point. First player to get 10 points wins!
